**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO APPROVE COMPROMISE FOR ORDER,
PURSUANT TO SECTION 105(a) OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE AND RULE
9019 OF THE FEDERAL RULES OF BANKRUPTCY PROCEDURE,
APPROVING PROCEDURES FOR THE SETTLEMENT OF AVOIDANCE
TRANSFER CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION**

On August 29, 2007, Debtors CEP Holdings, Inc. d/b/a www.colonendparenthesis.net, a/d/b/a Coastin88.com, a/d/b/a CEPCoast.com and Colon End Parenthesis Trust, LLC (collectively, the "Debtors"), filed their Motion to Approve Compromise for Order, Pursuant to Section 105(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and Rule 9019 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Approving Procedures for the

Settlement of Avoidance Transfer Claims and Causes of Action [Docket No. 72] (the "Motion"). The Court held a hearing on the Motion on October 16, 2007. No objections to the Motion were filed or announced at the hearing.

The Court has considered the Motion and all other matters of record in these cases, and after due deliberation, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Motion is granted, as follows:

a) the Debtors shall have blanket authority to settle Avoidable Transfer Claims,¹ where the Debtors' gross demand amount with respect thereto is less than \$30,000, without being required to file a motion seeking approval of such settlement pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9019 or any further notice or order of the Court;

b) With respect to each proposed settlement of an Avoidable Transfer Claim against transferees who are not residents of the United States if the gross demand amount of the claim is \$30,000 or more, the Debtors shall provide notice thereof to each of the Debtors' twenty largest creditors, *via* e-mail, but no motion or notice need be filed with the Court. After notice is given, each of the Debtors' twenty largest creditors shall have 3 business days to object, in writing by return e-mail, to the proposed settlement. If no timely objection is received, the Debtors shall have authority to consummate the settlement without further order, notice, or hearing. If any objections are not resolved by the Debtors and the objecting part(ies), the Debtors may file a motion to approve settlement with the Court pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9019, and the procedures in paragraph (c), *infra*;

¹ The capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Motion.

c) the Debtors shall have authority to settle an Avoidable Transfer Claim against transferees who are residents of the United States where the gross demand amount is \$30,000 or more (with the exception of the Insider Adversary and the SureInvest Adversary), provided that the Debtors shall file a motion to approve compromise with this Court pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9019, which the Court may approve without a hearing if no party in interest files an objection to the settlement at issue within 15 days of service of said motion. If an objection is timely filed, the Court will consider the motion and objection at a hearing on same; and

d) with respect to the Insider Adversary and the SureInvest Adversary, the Debtors shall comply with the requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 9019, except that the Debtors shall have authority to settle their claims against Clifford Barany in the Insider Adversary without being required to file a motion seeking approval of such settlement pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9019 or any further notice or order of the Court.
